Pinot Noir	2006	<p>Like the magpies, this pinot noir is unique. Paraparap Pinot Noir	2006	<p>This pinot noir displays characteristics of mixed peel and spice and a layer of mocha and cigar box decadence from maturation in French oak. The wine lingers with supple chamois like tannins.</p> <p>James Halliday Australian Wine Companion – 92 points</p>
